I hope you all enjoyed your long weekend! Following is a summary of what we have already done and what we will do this week for each of the grades:

Math

6th – We started solving problems using double number lines. This week, we are going to use the test we took last week to take another look at how to use double number lines. Then we will move on to creating equations given the values in ratio tables and plotting the points in tables onto a coordinate plane.

7th- Last week we started learning how to take the percentage of given values. This week, we are going to revisit operations with fractions and then move on to writing equations of graphs with proportional relationships.

8th- We have been working with magnitude and estimation. This week, we will take what we know about these two topics to rewrite numbers into scientific notation and perform operations with numbers in scientific notation.
