New Teacher Assignments

Summer Assignments 2017

Enclosed with this letter, please find the summer assignments for students entering 1<sup>st</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Summer assignment packets will be for Math and ELA. Each assignment will count as a First Quarter project grade and will be due on September 11<sup>th</sup>.

Physicals and Immunizations

Please remember to have your child visit the pediatrician over the summer for a physical and any needed immunizations. **Students entering Kindergarten should have their second MMR and students entering Grade 6 should have their Tdap. Students entering the 7<sup>th</sup> grade MUST have the Meningococcal vaccine. ALL students must have a current physical form on file with the school nurse.** Remember, the Department of Health requires these immunizations, and a student will be suspended from classes in September if all immunizations and complete physical forms are not provided. Current immunization records are state mandated and will be strictly enforced in September. Enclosed in this envelope please find the state immunization requirements and a new physical examination form.


Summer School 2017
