Dear 6th, 7th, and 8th Grade Families,

Hope you had a great three-day weekend! Following is a summary of what we have already done and what we will do this week for each of the grades:

Math

6th – We have been using tape diagrams to solve ratio word problems. This week, we will learn how to find the value of a ratio, use the value to determine equivalence, and create tables of equivalent ratios.

7th - Last week, we learned how to write an equation given the constant of a problem. This week, we will continue to write equations and use the equations to solve problems. We will also learn how to gather data from graphs.

8th - We have learned all the rules of exponents. This week, we will look at how base 10 exponents will help us understand magnitude. By the end of the week we will look at estimating quantities.
