Dear 6th, 7th, and 8th Grade Families and Students,
I hope you all enjoyed your long weekend! Following is a summary of what we have already done and what we will do this week for each of the grades:

Math

6th – We began writing equations for ratio tables. This week, we will learn to graph ordered pairs on a coordinate plane and then determine the rate.

7th- Last week, we began solving equations in order to become more comfortable with numerical operations. This week, we will learn to graph and write equations of proportional relationships involving fractions. By the end of the week, we will look at scale drawings and how they relate to ratios.

8th- We completed our operations with scientific notation. This week, we will compare numbers written in scientific notation and then learn about transformations and translations.
