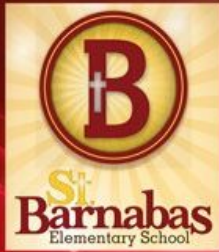

CLASS BASKET THEMES BY GRADE

Pre – K 3: Kid's Basket

Toys, games, hot wheels' cars, trucks, action figures, Spiderman, Batman, Star Wars, Transformers, Spongebob, PJ Mask, Paw Patrol, Ironman, Legos, sports toys-balls, baseballs, basketballs, soccer balls, jump ropes, hoola-hoops, bubbles, Barbie, Hello Kitty, Disney Princesses, Dora, stickers, hair ribbons, dress up items, and the like!

Pre-K4: Home Décor Basket

Any items for the home: picture frames, placemats, napkin rings or holders, glassware, serving trays, coasters, bowls, scented candles, diffusers, bath/hand towels, soap dish, votives, accent pillows, bowls, clock, bathroom accessories and the like!

Kindergarten: Family Night Basket

Board games, puzzles, playing cards, and the like!

First Grade: Arts & Craft Basket

Paint, crayons, markers, colored pencils, shape scissors, canvas, construction paper, playdough, chalk, glue and the like!

Second Grade: Movie Night Basket

DVDs, movie tickets, Netflix vouchers, snacks, popcorn/bowls, candy, M&Ms, Twizzlers, Skittles, Starburst, and the like!

Third Grade: Summer Fun Basket
